The Supreme Court today granted the writ of certiorari in this case. All the Justices concur, except Benham, J., who dissents.

This case will be assigned to the April 2016 oral argument calendar automatically under Supreme Court Rule 50 (2), as amended September 13, 1996. Oral argument is mandatory in granted certiorari cases.

This Court is particularly concerned with the following issue or issues:

Did the Court of Appeals correctly determine that the 180-day time limitation for the State to obtain an indictment under OCGA § 17-7-50.1 cannot be waived by a juvenile?

Briefs should be submitted only on these points. See Supreme Court Rule 45.
